“ANTIGONE - Information and Documentation Center on Racism, Ecology, Peace and Non-Violence” in collaboration with Ecological Movement of Thessaloniki (National EuroVelo Coordination Center) organise an **One-Day Conference** under the framework of **South East Europe (SEE) Programme “Iron Curtain Trail (ICT): Sustainable mobility along the newest EuroVelo route”**.

“Iron Curtain Trail” project involves the connection of South East regions with a long distance cycling route aiming to a European-wide cooperation for the development and the promotion of EuroVelo 13 route.

ICT Conference is going to take place on **Thursday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013** from **9.00-17.00** in the **New City Hall of Thessaloniki** (Vasileos Georgiou 1) with the participation of national, regional and local representatives, Local Development Organisations (Austria, Hungary, Slovenia, Bulgaria), Non Governmental Organisations (Greece, Slovakia, Serbia, Hungary, Bulgaria) as well as other stakeholders (representatives of cycling associations, tourism and travel related services, transport services etc.).

Conference presentations will be on “Iron Curtain Trail” project progress, goals, upcoming activities and common methodologies that have been developed so far for the implementation of survey on new cycling routes. The participants will have the opportunity to get informed on good practices in various South East Europe regions as far as it concerns sustainable transportations, sustainable mobility and cycling tourism.
